Between-The-Heads Golf Tour '12 Itinerary

Thursday 9 August

We will be staying at the 4-star Protea Hotel Knysna Quays, overlooking the magical Knysna lagoon and facing the warm Indian Ocean through the world famous Knysna heads.

With one of the best hotel locations in South Africa, our base for the weekend provides doorstep access to the lagoon and most of the attractions this historic town offers.

Our opening round for the weekend will be played at Pezula with our first tee-off at 12:20.

Pezula is on the eastern head and is probably one of the most scenic golf courses in South Africa. The course offers a sweeping spectacle of fairways and greens rolling through the pristine Southern Cape landscape, promising an unsurpassed golf experience.

The evening is spent at leisure, a good opportunity to digest something else Knysna is famous for, home-grown oysters.

Friday 10 August

One of the pristine courses in the Southern Cape is the Goose Valley golf course just outside Plettenberg Bay, our host for today's round. Tee-off is only from 11:40, allowing you to recover from the oysters and excess champagne from the previous nights' celebrations.

You will experience breathtaking views of the Keurbooms Lagoon, the Indian Ocean, the spectacular Tsitsikamma Mountains and the famous Robberg Peninsula. The beauty of the natural

fynbos, indigenous trees and an abundance of animal and bird life add a special dimension to your golfing experience.

Once back in Knysna why not visit the Knysna waterfront and share a couple lagers with your golf friends!

Saturday 11 August

Today will be the highlight of the tour. Not only will we play golf on one of the most beautiful courses in the country, but we will also spend some time on the water, enjoying a sunset cruise and buffet dinner.

Simola is our last round for the tour, and for those that have played this course before will testify that this will be a round to remember. Tee-off is at 11:30 allowing us an early morning breakfast with a short drive up to the course.

Simola (www.simolaestate.co.za) is the first Jack Nicklaus signature course in the garden route. Keeping your head down at this course will prove to be difficult as the scenery around us will overwhelm you.

After the golf we will have time for a quick beer or two after which we will head down to the Knysna Harbour where we will board the Paddle Cruiser Ferry at 17:45 for a sunset cruise to remember. While enjoying the scenery with a drink in hand we will be served a 3-course buffet dinner fit for kings.

Returning under the stars at approximately 20:00, it still leaves more than enough time to end the weekend at some of the hotspots in Knysna.

Sunday 12 August

So, as soon as you can get your head off the pillow and enjoy a final breakfast it is time to head back to your loved ones.
